REVELATION: Study #4

Revelation 2:12-29

<u>WARM UP</u>: What does it mean to compromise? In what ways are people often tempted to compromise?

Questions:

- Read verse 12. Why does Jesus refer to Himself as "the One who has the sharp two-edged sword?" What does this "sword" represent (Hebrews 4:12)? Why would it be important for the church of Pergamum to see Jesus this way?
- 2) Read verses 13-15. What did this church do well? What does Jesus have against this church?
- 3) Righteousness stays far away from sin. Compromise is seeing how near you can get to sin without crossing the line. Why is compromise so dangerous for Christians?
- 4) What are some ways the church is compromising today? What are some examples of popular false beliefs or teachings today?
- 5) Read verses 18-21. What did this church do well? What does Jesus have against this church?
- 6) What warnings did He give them (read verses 22-23)? Why?

APPLICATION:

1. In what ways are you tempted to compromise in your faith in the midst of our culture? What are some things you need to do personally to prevent it?
